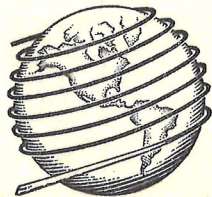


More than 7 TIMES AROUND

The story of the Burlington Zephyrs is one of the most brilliant and fascinating chapters in all American rail history. In May, 1934, the first of these renowned speedsters startled the travel world with its famous non-stop run from Denver to Chicago in 785 minutes. Today there are eight Zephyr trains in regular daily service, flashing over high-speed runs that call for an amazing total of nearly 183,000 miles of scheduled operation per month . . . close to 2,200,000 miles per year.

So closely have developments in high-speed rail service been associated with this famous train family that today the one word "Zephyr" is frequently used to describe any ultra-modern, ultra-swift, ultra-fine travel. An ever-growing popular demand for accommodations has naturally followed, resulting in the building of additional cars for these flyers, and even in the construction of an entirely new ninth Zephyr train, for delivery early in 1939.

Small wonder indeed that The Burlington is proud of its diesel-powered fleet built of gleaming stainless steel.

THE ZEPHYR FAMILY

Denver Zephyrs—daily service between Chicago and Denver . . . "just overnight" between the Great Lakes and the Rockies. Matchless accommodations for both overnight and daytime travel.

Twin Zephyrs—double daily service between Chicago, St. Paul and Minneapolis . . . twice a day each way along the Mississippi River Scenic Line, "where Nature smiles for 300 miles."

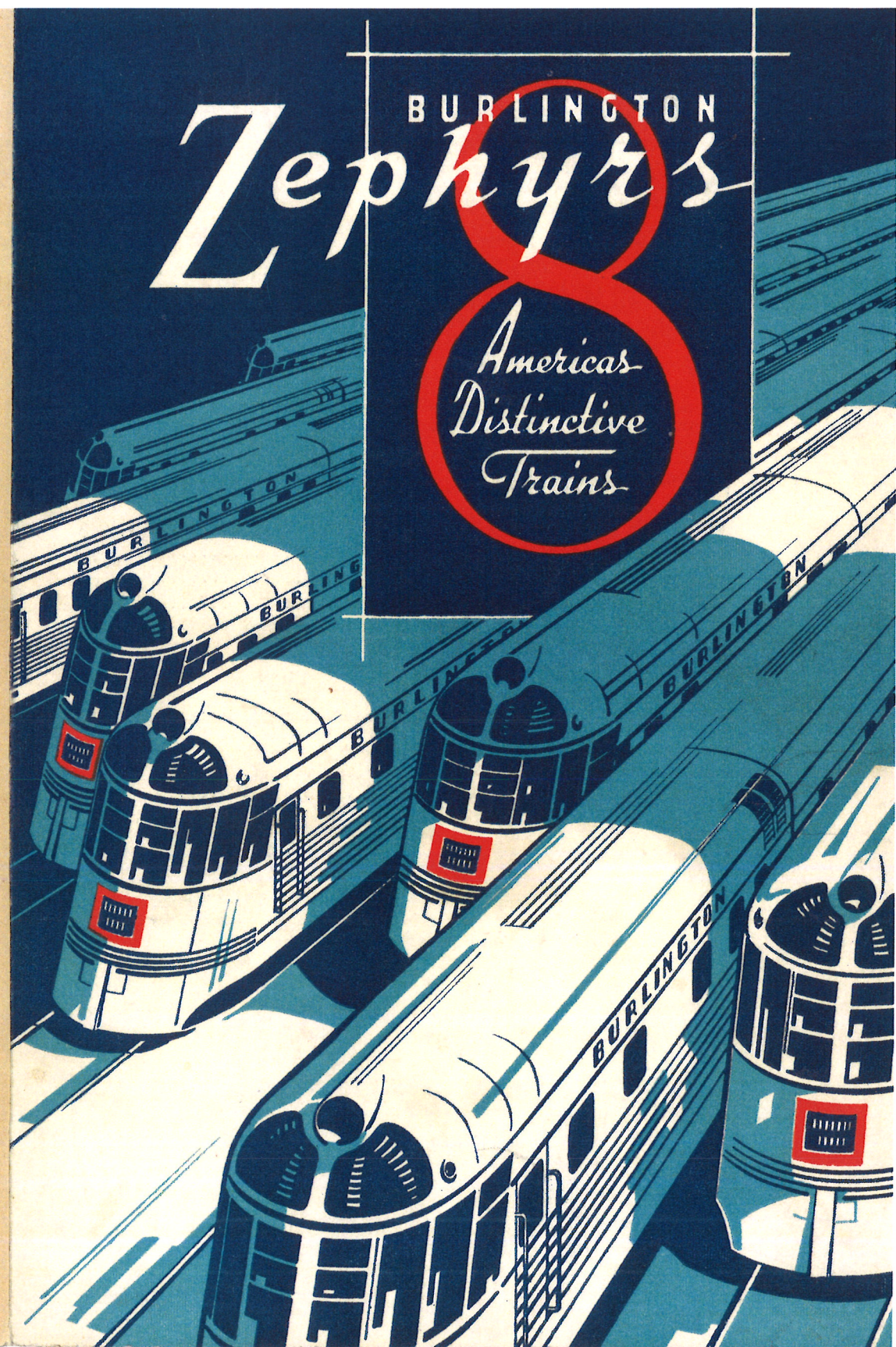
Ozark State Zephyrs—double daily service between St. Louis and Kansas City . . . fast daylight schedules over the most direct route. Operated jointly by Burlington Route and Alton Railroad.

Sam Houston Zephyr and Texas Rocket—double daily service between Houston, Dallas and Fort Worth . . . through a region rich with memories of the doughty Texan, Sam Houston. Operated by Burlington-Rock Island Lines.
