## WEST FACADE OF THE FEDERAL GROUP At the Century of Progress Exposition


The three great pylons typify the three functions of the Federal Government—Judicial, Legislative, and Executive. The pylons are triangular in cross-section. The inner faces will be illuminated as from a hidden fire. The outer faces will be treated in an iridescent blue. At the axis of the building and located within its dome, will be a vertically disposed high-intensity searchlight throwing a powerful blue-white beam into the air. The candlepower of this beam will be approximately 800,000.
