VACATION ROUTE

In this great land of ours, Nature very wisely saw to it that things were different—that as we move about here at home in America we find an unbelievable variety of scenic attractions. And instead of just talking about the weather, we can really do something about it.

For an escape from summer's oppressive heat, there is the magnetic lure of nearby, cool, wonderful *Colorado* . . . glorious playground of the Rockies. Within its borders is the greatest extent and widest variety of mountain scenery to be found anywhere in the world. Here are 325 peaks whose craggy heads rise to heights of 10,000 feet or more. At least 25 Colorado peaks surpass the 14,109 feet of that famous old patriarch, Pikes Peak. An endless array of scenic thrills are at hand—tumbling mountain streams, gem-like lakes, deep forests, prehistoric ruins, old mining camps. The average elevation is 6,800 feet above sea level; higher than that of any other state.

On the other hand, when King Winter moves in, how natural it is to want to get away to golden sands, flower-scented breezes, the beach parasol, the sun-drenched out-of-doors. Thoughts then turn to our *Gulf of Mexico Riviera* . . . that vast winter playground extending from romantic Mexico to the palm-fringed shores of the Florida Keys. Choose your sport! There's big game fishing for the deep-sea fighters—golfing on marvelous green courses, racing, tennis, polo, and a score of others. There's swimming through white-crested breakers or in tepid pools, surf-riding, or plain lazing on white beaches. There are gay night clubs and delightful old Spanish and French restaurants, romantic century-old churches, missions, ancient market places and other edifices.

Conveniently connecting these fascinating though vastly different regions is the Colorado-Texas route of the *Burlington Lines*, with the diesel-powered, stainless steel *Texas Zephyrs* leaving Denver and Dallas—Fort Worth shortly after noon every day and arriving at the other end of the line the next morning. The *Sam Houston Zephyr*, named for the illustrious Texas statesman, plies daily between the North Texas metropolitan area of Dallas and Fort Worth and the bustling metropolis of Houston in the high-speed comfort so typical of the great Burlington Zephyr fleet, thus affording streamline train service over the entire direct line rail route between the *Colorado Rockies* and the *Gulf Coast*.
