REGULATIONS COVERING THE SALE OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SANTE FE LINES

- ILLINOIS.....Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except before noon on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open.
- IOWA.....No sales of Liquor, Wine or Beer.
- MISSOURI.....Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open.
- KANSAS.....Kansas 3.2 beer sold except on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open. Sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- OKLAHOMA.....Oklahoma 3.2 beer sold except before noon on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open. Sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- TEXAS.....Beer sold only between Saginaw and Crowley; Valley Mills and Houston (local option), except before 1:00 P. M. on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open. Sale of other alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- COLORADO.....Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except on Sundays and Christmas Day before 8:00 A.M. or after 8:00 P.M. and on Election Days while polls are open. No sales before 8:00 A.M. on any day.
- NEW MEXICO...Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except on Sundays and Election Days while polls are open (but no sales East of Taiban on Southern District - local option).
- ARIZONA.....Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except before noon on Sundays and on Election Days while polls are open.
- CALIFORNIA....Liquor, Wine and Beer sold except on Election Days while polls are open. No sales before 8:00 A.M. on any day.

No sales of Alcoholic Beverages after midnight or before 7:00 A.M.
