The Hopi Indians believe that the Kachina is a supernatural being who is impersonated by a man wearing a mask. The Kachinas are similar to Christian saints and are supposed to carry prayers to the Hopi gods that live on the San Francisco Peaks of Arizona and other high mountains.

Hopi children believe in Kachinas just as many children do in Santa Claus; and as Santa Claus comes at a certain season bearing gifts, so certain Kachinas bring Kachina dolls which are small representations of the supernatural beings.

The dolls are hand-carved from dry cottonwood roots and painted in bright colors. There are about 200 different classifications of Kachina dolls and for many years they have been treasured items of Indian lore.
