Here are age-old inhabited Indian pueblos, prehistoric cliff dwellings, colorful ranches, abode missions, primitive villages tucked away in the mountains where the hand of civilization has touched but lightly . . . all under a golden sun and a sky as blue as turquoise, and tempered by crystal-clear air and sparkling year 'round climate.

Santa Fe is the oldest capital in the United States (founded about 1610 by the Spaniards as La Villa Real de la Santa Fe de San Francisco de Assisi, "Royal City of Holy Faith of St. Francis Assisi").

Today, much of the charm and enchantment of this ancient city appears very like the scene depicted on the cover of this menu. This scene has been reproduced from a painting by Leonard Reedy.
