THE LAND OF PUEBLOS
ALONG THE SANTA FE

Taos Pueblo, at the foot of the Taos Mountains in New Mexico about seventy-five miles north of Santa Fe, is the largest and most widely known of all the age-old Indian pueblos in the Southwest.

Here the unchanging ways of Indian life, the soft sunlight, and the luminous color attract artists from all over the world.

There are many pueblos, quaint Spanish-Indian villages, and unusual scenery along the Santa Fe Route through the Southwest. Travelers can explore this interesting country by motor with courier-driver on an Indian-detour from Santa Fe, New Mexico.
